ORDER

On June 30, 2026, the Court held a telephonic status conference to discuss settlement notices that were returned to the Clerk of Court, Billings Division, after being marked and returned as undeliverable. (*See* Docs. 154, 155, 156, 157, 159.) To date, the Clerk's office has received thirty-six of these letters, which have been docketed in the Court's record. The Court will continue to docket these undeliverable notices as they are received.

Counsel for Plaintiff stated that the Settlement Administrator is aware these notices are being erroneously returned to the Clerk's office, and is actively

attempting to find correct addresses for the potential class members who have not yet received notice of the potential settlement of this case. The Settlement Administrator is attempting to contact these potential class members by telephone to obtain correct addresses. Failing that, the Settlement Administrator will conduct skip tracing on these potential class members to determine their current mailing addresses. Counsel for the Plaintiff advised that this process could be completed, and notices sent to these class members by July 6, 2026.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED new notices shall be mailed to the new addresses the Settlement Administrator is able to obtain no later than July 8, 2026. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that due to the unforeseen delay in the delivery of notice, the deadline for potential class members to object to the settlement is extended from July 13, 2026, to July 31, 2026. All notices mailed by the Settlement Administrator following the entry of this Order shall reflect this updated deadline.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
